Good Evening Ladies & Gentlemen I Kavita Jakher feel very proud and privileged to present the Annual Report.

Education acts as an integrative force in the society. We at APS Hisar ensure inclusive equitable quality education and life long learning to the wards of Army Personnel. We strive to provide the knowledge and Skills needed to promote sustainable development and life style. It is our Endeavour to make our learners imbibe the culture of peace, non violence, Global citizenship and appreciation of cultural diversity by imparting values that foster social cohesion and national identity.

The session 2019- 20 has been a very rewarding session so far.

In terms of **infrastructure** 12 additional fully equipped Pre Fabricated Classrooms were inaugurated and made functional for the students of class I and II. 32 CCTV Cameras were added to the already existing 64 Cameras. A Firewall was also installed for the purpose of Cyber Security. A set of fire hydrants and hose reel was purchased. A statement of case for the construction of multi utility activity shed is under progress. School has got a CTS Grant of 4.5 Lacs which is being utilized for the purchase of outdoor Gym equipment for our Students.

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and is the yardstick for gauging its stature in the society. The Prestigious education World Magazine rated APS Hisar as the 6th best school in Haryana in the category of Co-education day schools. Class X and XII Results of the School continued to be excellent. In Class X , the result was 100% with 64 Students scoring 90% &

above and 2 students Master Jaideep Singh and Miss Jyoti Kumari scoring 100/100 in Hindi and 3 students Master Harsh Kumar, Miss Riya and Shruti scoring 100/100 in mathematics. In Class XII, the result was 100% with 20 Student scoring 90% & above and 1 Student Miss Jasmine scoring 100/100 in Political Science.

A sum of Rs. 1,21,500/- was distributed to the meritorious students of class 10th and 12th who excelled in their Board result as Cash incentive.

Our School bagged 3rd position and got Rs. 30,000/- in command for overall excellence. Master Arman Dixit, Sahil Phogat and Vijay Kumar got selected in NDA, Indian Naval Academy and OTA Chennai respectively. Master Gagan Yadav, Aman Sharma, Abhishek and Jatin Kumar got selected in Army Institute of Technology, Pune. Master Neeraj Sharma and Miss Priya Goyal got selected in State Govt Medical Colleges and Master Himashu and Miss Kiran got selected for MBBS in Army College of Medical Science, New Delhi. 14 Students got placed in various professional colleges.

8 Students namely Master Nitin Kaswan, Miss Harshita, Monika, Neha, Jasmine, Sonu, Jyoti and Annu and 2 Teachers Mrs Suman Ghanghas (Vice Principal) and Mr Narendar, PGT Physical Education were felicitated for their academic performance by Amity University.

An Alumni Meet was conducted in the month of Oct to reconnect and celebrate the success of our Alumni who are making us proud in different professional fields.

Games & Sports play an important role in our life. It makes children active and agile and develops their mental abilities, initiates team building and gives wings to their passion. Not only do our students participate and excel in the local level tournaments but also at the district, zonal level and International Level. Our students have also dominated the sports scene at the Command Level. Miss Neha a Students of Class XI made the school proud at the International level by bagging 3 Gold and 1 Silver Medal at various International Championships held at Poland, Spain, Germany and Saudi Arab. Our sub junior Football Team made us proud by winning the City Championship organized by Reliance Foundation at Rohtak and Cash Incentive of Rs 25,000/-. Our students also bagged various medals in Karate and Athletics.

To take part is what counts in competition and lessons of victory and defeat are what we get in return. This environment was adequately created through Inter Class, Inter-House and Inter- School competitions such as debates, Vad-Vivaad Pratiyogita, Shlok Competition, Quiz, Rangoli, Declamation, Creative- Writing,

Spelling-Bee, Drawing and Power – Point competitions. **Smart Street Light Project** of our School ATAL Tinkering Lab was selected amongst the top 100 projects of and our Team comprising of Master Jatin and Harsh along with their Mentor was invited to showcase the same at the Vibrant Gujrat Summit. Master Amit Kumar, Ritik, Miss Nidhi and Anjum were recognized as the ATL Student Innovators.

Conforming to the guidelines from Directorate of Education & CBSE and to disseminate the message of a better habitable environment free of pollution, an Anti- Pollution Rally was organized by our students in the AWWA Residential Complex. With the same thought, a Cleanliness Drive under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was also undertaken.

To Promote harmony across all communities, Special Assemblies are conducted on a regular basis wherein all the Festivals and important days are fondly celebrated.

Celebration like 15 August, 26 January, Eid, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Christmas, Gandhi Jayanti, Teacher’s Day, Children’s Day, Army Day, Navy Day, Communal Harmony Week, Road safety Week etc kept the school humming with activities all year through. A visit to Splash Water Park, Kasauli and The Parliament was organized during the session Movies like **Harry Potter, The Lion King, Ice Age and Baby’s Day out** were screened for our students at The Lancer Cinema Hall over a period of 4 days preceding children’s day.

In NCC School has been allocated Full Troop JD Boys and Half Troop JW Girls. We have 95 Boy Cadets and 61 Girl Cadets Annual Training Camp of NCC was conducted at Shri Krishna Pranami Public School, Siwani wherein our cadets outshined and brought laurels to the School.

Our students get the first taste of democracy and leadership qualities through the totally computerized Voting system in Student Council Elections.

In keeping with the school’s policy of continuous up gradation of knowledge and skills, our teachers attended various Capacity Building workshops organized by CBSE and FDRC so as to hone their academic transactional skills.

Safety, Emotional and physical well being of our students is of utmost importance to us. To ensure that our students are well equipped with knowledge to face any challenge, we organized mock drills for Fire Safety, Natural Disaster Management and Anti Terrorist Attacks. The legal literacy cell of the school conducted sessions on Juvenile Justice and POCSO Act. Our senior students attended webinars of eminent Doctor and Psychologist from Fortis group of Hospital. In addition to that the Good Touch and Bad Touch awareness

along with menstrual hygiene workshops were conducted for our students. Focused sessions on Career Counseling, Leadership Skills, Career Planning and Development, Cyber Security capsule by Ms Neeru Hasija, Dr. Satya Sawant, Dr. Pragya Kaushik, Mr Dinesh Nagpal, Mr Davinder Thakral, Col Sofia Quereshi, Lt Jorawar Singh and Sub Rashpal Singh Students also got to interact with Ms Vaijayanti Savant Tonpe a childrens Author.

I would like to place on record heartfelt gratitude to our worthy Patron for being so keenly involved in the Day to day functioning of the School. Sir you not only took out time to personally interact with the students of the Board Class and also ensured that the Tuition Fee of Miss Neha who made the school proud at the International level was waived off. As a result of an initiative taken by the worthy Patron HQ South Western Command sanctioned a scholarship of Rs 72,000/- upto class XII out of QD.
