  The maximum number of tests to be taken remains 9 only i.e. 2 Languages + 6 Domain Specific Subjects + 1 General Test OR Languages + 5 Domain Specific Subjects + 1 General Aptitude Test: flexibility being provided to help a candidate apply for many Universities depending on his/her eligibility conditions). Total Tests = 61 (Inclusive of all sections)

  Section II offers 27 Subjects, out of which a candidate may choose a maximum of 6 Subjects. 27 Domain Specific Subjects divided into two groups: B1 and B2. 18 B1 Subjects: Accountancy, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, History, etc. 9 B2 Subjects: Entrepreneurship, Mass Media, Mass Communication, etc.

  For choosing Languages from Section IA and IB and domain specific Subjects from Section III and General Aptitude Test under Section III, the candidate must refer to the requirements of his/her intended University.
